


RESULTS FOR SMILE TRAIN AND POLAR BEAR/ PENGUIN PICNIC

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." - John 3:16




My love for them continues to be so strong as they grow older and I cannot fathom ever losing them. Then I look around and see friends of mine
